

**2. Income Tax Legislation (Amendment) Bill 2019 –
Third Reading approved; Bill passed**

Mr Henderson to move:

That the Income Tax Legislation (Amendment) Bill 2019 be read a third time and do pass.

The President: We turn now to Item 2, Income Tax Legislation (Amendment) Bill.
I call on the mover, Mr Henderson.

5 This Bill confirms three Temporary Taxation Orders, two of which it also amends. It also makes a number of amendments to the Income Tax Act 1970.

10 One of the main purposes of this Bill is to provide that three measures that formed part of the 2018 Budget and which were approved by Tynwald at that time can continue to have effect. These measures address the Island's domestic tax system, providing more assistance for those incurring nursing expenses, greater choice for those who want to save for their retirement, as well as helping to ensure everyone pays their fair share of tax.

The other main purpose of this Bill is to make three amendments to the Income Tax Act 1970.
