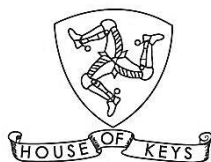

What progress has been made to enable Isle of Man households to be included in a flood reinsurance scheme?

2. The Hon. Member for Arbory, Castletown and Malew (Mr Moorhouse) to ask the Minister for the Treasury –

What criteria are used to ensure an individual is correctly classified as self-employed for the purpose of tax decisions?

3. The Hon. Member for Ramsey (Mr Hooper) to ask the Minister for the Treasury –

What plans he has to enable all people in receipt of benefits to be able to receive money direct to their bank account?

4. The Hon. Member for Ayre and Michael (Mr Baker) to ask the Minister for Policy and Reform –

What is being done to facilitate the employment of care leavers within Isle of Man Government?

5. The Hon. Member for Ramsey (Mr Hooper) to ask the Minister for Policy and Reform –

What assessment there has been in respect of the contribution to the local economy provided by: a) Post Office providing postal services; or b) the ability of people to collect benefits or pensions from a location within the local area?

6. The Hon. Member for Middle (Mr Shimmins) to ask the Minister for Enterprise –

What progress he has made with establishing a Manx Development Agency to help drive urban regeneration?

7. The Hon. Member for Ramsey (Mr Hooper) to ask the Minister for the Health and Social Care –

What support there is for GP practices to enable them to develop and utilise new approaches to offering patient appointments?

8. The Hon. Member for Garff (Mr Perkins) to ask the Minister for Infrastructure –

What consultation has he had with the RNLI about where the lifeboat will be relocated to if Douglas Harbour is redeveloped; and whether the new boat house will be ready for the bicentenary celebrations in 2023/4?

If he will make a statement on progress with each of the individual recommendations set out in section 3.1 of the 2013 Housing Review Recommendations Report?

If she will publish the Equality Impact Assessment and the Business Case relating to the possible changes in services available at Ballasalla Post Office?

(a) how many self-service machines the Post Office has had in use; (b) how many days each year was each machine out of use; (c) what the total cost of each machine and the annual maintenance costs were; (d) what the total revenue – mean lowest and highest was; (e) how many post office service contracts ended, and for what reasons; and (f) how many new contracts there were in each of the last five years?
