Report of the Police Complaints Commissioner for the year ended 31 March 2016

To the Minister,

I submit this report for your information as required under Paragraph 11(4) of Schedule 1 to the Police Act 1993.

At the beginning of the statistical year 1st April 2014 to 31st March 2015 there were 9 complaints on-going. These were dealt with as follows –
