Immigration Act 1971

IMMIGRATION (DESIGNATION OF TRAVEL BANS) (REVOCAION) ORDER 2016

Laid before Tynwald: 19 July 2016
Coming into operation in accordance with article 2

The Council of Ministers makes the following Order under section 8B(5) of the Immigration Act 1971, as that Act has effect in the Island¹.

1 Title

This Order is the Immigration (Designation of Travel Bans) (Revocation) Order 2016.

2 Commencement

This Order comes into operation immediately before the Immigration (Isle of Man) (Amendment) (No.2) Order 2016² comes into force.

3 Revocation

The Immigration (Designation of Travel Bans) Order 2016³ is revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE***(This note is not part of the Order)***

This Order revokes the Immigration (Designation of Travel Bans) Order 2016 (SD 2016/0048) immediately before the Immigration (Isle of Man) (Amendment) (No.2) Order 2016 comes into force. That UK statutory instrument will amend the Immigration Act 1971 (of Parliament) (the “1971 Act”) as it has effect in the Isle of Man in line with amendments made to the 1971 Act as it has effect in the United Kingdom by the Immigration Act 2016 (of Parliament).

The amendments to the 1971 Act will result in persons who are subject to travel bans under instruments of the United Nations and the Council of the European Union being subject to those restrictive measures under the 1971 Act and will remove the requirement for further secondary legislation to be made to designate each new UN or EU instrument.
