1. **The Hon Member for Ramsey (Mr Singer) to ask the Chief Minister -**
Was the Government offered the opportunity to purchase the Lake Road/Quiggin's Yard site and, if so, when?

2. **The Hon Member for Michael (Mr Cannan) to ask the Chief Minister -**
Has the Council of Ministers ordered the Chief Secretary to establish a working party to formulate a policy to create a single statutory board to manage both water supply and drainage, and if so
 - (a) **what are the terms of reference;**
 - (b) **who are members of the working party; and**
 - (c) **are Members of the House of Keys to be consulted?**

3. The Hon Member for Douglas North (Mr Houghton) to ask the Minister for the Treasury -

Will the Treasury review the financial benefits of amending the Legal Aid Act 1986 to provide that those who receive criminal legal aid and are convicted may be ordered to repay any criminal legal aid granted for their representation on any subsequent charge for which they are convicted?

4. The Hon Member for Michael (Mr Cannan) to ask the Minister for Tourism and Leisure -

Does your Department propose to re-introduce the Tourist Development Fund to provide grant assistance for the provision of new tourist accommodation?

5. The Hon Member for Douglas West (Mr Shimmin) to ask the Minister for Transport -

What discussions have you had with the Department of Education with a view to resolving the situation concerning Murray's Road Junior School's playground being turned into a car park?

6. The Hon Member for Douglas East (Mrs Cannell) to ask the Minister for Transport -

Will Douglas Promenade be free of plant and repair machinery in time for the Easter holiday period?

(3) what were the annual legal aid caseloads; and

(4) what do you estimate will be the percentage increase in these caseloads year on year for the next two years?

(1) What are the pay scales for nurses employed in the National Health Service; and

(2) what are the comparable scales in the United Kingdom?

When do you propose to issue the annual progress report, in terms of paragraph 1(b) of the Douglas Transport Strategy Implementation Report, and meet Members for the Douglas constituencies to discuss it?
