1. The Hon Member for Ramsey (Mr Singer) to ask the Member for Health and Social Security -
 - (1) How many women over 50 years of age have taken advantage of the voluntary breast screening service since its introduction; and
 - (2) has your Department any plans to extend this service to women between 40 and 50 years of age?

2. The Hon Member for Douglas North (Mr Houghton) to ask the Minister for Local Government and the Environment -

Has your Department -

 - (a) imposed by delegated legislation a planning requirement that there should be adequate access to buildings for the physically disabled; or
 - (b) published its policy and advice on such access?

- (2) how many are expected to be built in each of the current and next financial years?

Does your Department intend to introduce a revised mortgage assistance scheme which will enhance the opportunities of the low paid to purchase their own property?

- (1) Has your Department's working party on the redevelopment of the Isle of Man prison reported;
- (2) if so -
 - (a) what are its recommendations, and
 - (b) will you publish the report; and
- (3) if not, when do you expect it to report?

- (1) What roads are considered by your Department to be threatened by coastal erosion; and
- (2) in each case, over what period does your Department anticipate that the threat will be realised?

When do you propose to inform Members of the contents and recommendations of the Beamans Report?
