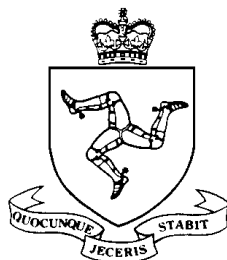

#### **1. Questions for Oral Answer**

1. The Hon Member (Mr Lowey) to ask a Member of the Council of Ministers (Mrs Christian) -

  - (2) how much new office accommodation has been completed, purchased or leased for use by Government or its agencies during the present year; and
  - (3) how much new office accommodation for use by Government and its agencies is programmed for the next eighteen months?
  
2. The Hon Member (Mr Lowey) to ask a Member of the Treasury (Mr Radcliffe) -
  - (1) How many written notices have been issued in the last twelve months under -
    - (a) section 10 of the Investment Business Act 1991; and

- (b) section 16 of the Banking Act 1998;
  - (2) have the relevant bodies been informed; and, if not
  - (3) what is the result of the consideration given to making a wider promulgation of the existence of such notices which was promised by the Minister for the Treasury during the sitting of Tynwald on 21<sup>st</sup> March 2000?
3. The Hon Member (Mr Waft) to ask a Member of the Treasury (Mr Radcliffe) -
- (1) What guidelines will be made available to those members of the public who wish to set up a Personal Pension or Annuity for their future which will keep pace with inflation, equivalent to superannuation schemes available to public sector workers; and
  - (2) is there a possibility of Treasury setting up a joint scheme for those who are not in a superannuated position?
