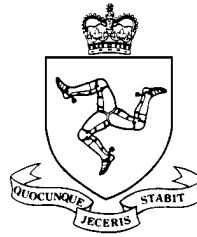

4. Joint Committee of Tynwald on the Emoluments of Certain Public Servants

Mr Lowey to move -

That the First Report of the Joint Committee on the Emoluments of Certain Public Servants 2006-2007 be received and the following recommendations be approved -

1. That the Payment of Members Expenses Act 1989 be amended to provide that when a Member of the Legislative Council goes out of Office as a Member of the Council, he or she should continue in Office as a Minister, Member of a Department or Chairman of a Statutory Board, until a successor is appointed and thereby receive the remuneration due for that Executive Government role.
2. That the Payment of Members Expenses Act 1989 be amended to provide that when a Member of the Keys or Council, who chairs a Statutory Board, goes out of Office that individual should continue to receive the remuneration due for chairing the Board until a successor is appointed.
3. That the Members of Tynwald (Annual Sums) Order and the Statutory Boards (Annual Sums) Order be amended to require that if the Chairman of the MEA is a Member of Tynwald he or she should receive the same remuneration as those chairing politicians who chair other Statutory Boards.
