**ROAD RACES (AMENDMENT)  
BILL 2010**

**Explanatory Memorandum**

- 1.** This Bill, which is promoted by the Department of Infrastructure, amends the Road Races Act 1982 to allow racing on a Sunday using non-mechanically propelled vehicles.
- 2.** It is not expected that the Bill will have any financial implications.
- 3.** In the view of the member moving the Bill its provisions are compatible with the Convention rights within the meaning of the Human Rights Act 2001.

## A BILL

to amend further the Road Races Act 1982 to permit racing using non-mechanically propelled vehicles.

**B**E IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Council and Keys in Tynwald assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The short title of this Act is the Road Races (Amendment) Act 2011. Short title

2. For section 1(2) of the Road Races Act 1982 substitute — Amendment  
of the Road  
Races Act 1982

5 “(2) A road race order shall not authorise the use  
of any road for a race on a Sunday except — [c.14]

(a) in the case of vehicles that are not mechanically propelled; or

(b) as provided by subsections (3) and (3A).”.
