That Tynwald, recognising the increase of activity in the Isle of Man in controlled drugs, and in the sophistication of those trading in such drugs, is of the opinion -

- (a) that eight new posts should be created in the Isle of Man Constabulary to increase the Drug Squad to 16 members, and
- (b) that £250,000 be provided for both vital communication equipment and a drug audit to evaluate further the extent of controlled drug activity in the Island.
