## Notes

- (c) supports the introduction of legislation for the acquisition by the Government of the Villa Marina Complex, including the Arcade, Colonnade and Gardens.

**25. First-time Buyers' Houses -**

Mr Karran to move -

That Tynwald -

- (a) considers the provision by Government of 80 first-time buyers' houses per annum for the next five years to be insufficient; and
- (b) calls on the Department of Local Government and the Environment to -
  - (i) identify the sites where the proposed first-time buyers' houses will be located;
  - (ii) investigate ways of increasing the provision of first-time buyers' houses; and
  - (iii) consider the possibility of developing for this purpose 20 acres of the land purchased by Government for land-banking in the vicinity of Johnny Watterson's Lane;

and report to the October 1999 sitting.
