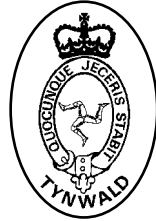

- (i) the coastline between Glen Wyllin access and Balleira Road access, Kirk Michael, be protected from erosion by a sea wall of boulders from Stoney Mountain; and
- (ii) the work be completed over a period of four years commencing April 2000.
