1. Business to be considered under Standing Order 2.2(6) -

The Minister for Trade and Industry to move -

That Standing Order 10.9 be suspended and that, under Standing Order 2.2(6), the following business be considered.

2. To lay before the Court -

Report of the Department of Trade and Industry on the Reinforcement and Diversification of the Island's Energy Supply, October 1998

3. Reinforcement and Diversification of the Island's Energy Supply -

The Minister for Trade and Industry to move -

That Tynwald, in furtherance of a policy of reinforcing and diversifying the Island's energy supplies -

- (1) supports the Manx Electricity Authority's decision to proceed with the installation of a single 40MW cable to the Island from Bispham in the United Kingdom, in co-operation with National Grid plc; and

- (2) notes that further work is to be carried out in relation to the Department of Trade and Industry's examination of a scheme for the importation of natural gas to the Island to fuel a 40MW gas-fired generating station at Pulrose and to facilitate a mains gas supply to consumers.
