 - (2) what estimated savings have been made during the last twelve months as a result of previous action taken by the Department on this matter?

2. The Hon Member for Ramsey (Mr Singer) to ask the Minister for Transport -

Will your Department introduce legislation to limit the maximum speed of heavy goods vehicles using Manx roads to 30 mph?

3. The Hon Member for Ayre (Mr Quine) to ask the Minister for Trade and Industry -
 - (1) Have you had occasion to express to Mrs Brenda Cannell MHK any dissatisfaction with the manner in which she has discharged her duties as a Member of your Department; and
 - (2) can you confirm that Mrs Cannell has, *inter alia*, had delegated responsibility for the construction industry, and that the manner

in which she has discharged her responsibilities has found favour with the industry's representatives?

As the Department of Education has adopted a policy of OFSTED style inspections of all the Island schools, when do you intend to carry out a similar inspection of the central administration and support services of the Department?

Are you considering introducing regulations to control the service and standards of companies providing a twenty-four hour call monitoring system for the elderly and disabled?

7. The Hon Member for Douglas North (Mr Henderson) to ask the Chairman of the Office of Fair Trading -

Will your Office be reviewing safety standards for the storage of fireworks in the Isle of Man?

Has your Authority received complaints of excessive chlorination of water from residents of properties adjacent to the Greenfield Road filtration plant?
