**5. Inland Fisheries Act 1976 -**

The Minister for Agriculture, Fisheries and Forestry to move -

That the Inland Fisheries (Duties) Regulations 1999 [SD No 744/99] be  
approved.

**6. Integrated Incinerator (Energy from Waste) Facility -**

The Minister for Local Government and the Environment to move -

That Tynwald -

- (a) approves the expenditure of a sum not exceeding £560,000 on fees to tender stage in respect of a scheme to provide an integrated incinerator (energy from waste) facility for the Island at Richmond Hill, Braddan, bringing the total approved to date to £1,324,000; and
- (b) authorises the Treasury to expend during the year ending 31<sup>st</sup> March 2000, from the Capital Transactions Account, a sum not exceeding £372,000 in respect of the additional expenditure.
