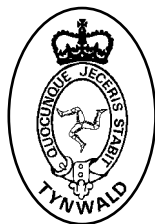

**3. Hyperbaric Chamber -**

Mr Houghton to move -

- (a) a qualified medical officer;
- (b) a chamber operator;
- (c) an assistant chamber operator who has nursing qualifications; and

that the Department reviews the financial provision for this facility every financial year.
