1. QUESTIONS FOR ORAL ANSWER

1. The Hon Member for Onchan (Mr Karran) to ask the Chief Minister -

What plans have the Council of Ministers to celebrate the 60th Anniversary of the end of World War II, to recognise those who made the supreme sacrifice to save us from Nazi tyranny?

2. The Hon Member for Onchan (Mr Karran) to ask the Minister for the Treasury -

In the event that the premises accommodating the ISD computers are not available, for whatever reason, what are the current contingency arrangements?

3. The Hon Member for Ramsey (Mrs Craine) to ask the Minister for Transport -

What effect is being brought to bear on the private sector by transferring the service of registering vehicles and issuing driving licences to Isle of Man Post from 1st April 2005?

4. **The Hon Member for Onchan (Mr Karran) to ask the Minister for Home Affairs -**

In relation to the covert listening devices at Isle of Man Police Headquarters, what was the cost to the taxpayer of -

- (a) the installation;**
- (b) the repair and maintenance; and**
- (c) who authorised these expenses?**

- (2) in the event of closure or insolvency, what protection is there to creditors of such companies?**

2. **The Hon Member for Michael (Mr Cannan) to ask the Chief Minister -**

- (1) Are you aware that the Planning Committee gave permission in August 2004 for residential development on land currently zoned in Braddan as a Business Park, identified as 23 in the draft Braddan Plan;**
- (2) do you agree this decision is unlawful in planning law; and, if so**
- (3) what action do you propose to take to rectify this situation?**

3. **The Hon Member for Middle (Mr Quayle) to ask the Minister for the Treasury -**

- (1) Will you provide an analysis of payments made by Treasury's Information Systems Division to consultants for the last five years, and to which companies such payments were made;**
- (2) in relation to the Connect-Man Project, what has been the overall cost of it since its inception and what progress has been made to date; and**

(3) what system do you have in place to measure performance of consultants to ensure that we receive value for money, and to revise contracts when necessary?

4. The Hon Member for Michael (Mr Cannan) to ask the Minister for Local Government and the Environment -

(1) Were private and confidential submissions accepted and used in formulating the draft Braddan Plan; and, if so

(2) by whom were the submissions made?
