To elect one Member of Tynwald in place of Mr Houghton.

(The existing Members of the Committee are Captain Douglas and Mr Shimmin).

74. Petition for Redress of Grievance of Dante and Joan Spadoni -

The Hon Member for Rushen (Mr Rimington) to move -

That a Select Committee of three Members be appointed with powers to take written and oral evidence pursuant to sections 3 and 4 of the Tynwald Proceedings Act 1876 to investigate the Petition for Redress of Grievance of Dante and Joan Spadoni presented at St John's on 5th July 2004 and to report with recommendations.

79. Petition for Redress of Grievance of Michael Andrew Cooil and Thomas Arthur Cooil -

The Hon Member for Castletown (Mr Speaker) to move -

That a Select Committee of three Members be appointed with powers to take written and oral evidence pursuant to sections 3 and 4 of the Tynwald Proceedings Act 1876 to investigate the Petitions for Redress of Grievance of Michael Andrew Cooil and Thomas Arthur Cooil presented at St John's on 5th July 2004 and to report with recommendations.

80. Amendment to Standing Order 5.7(2) -

The Hon Member for Onchan (Mr Karran) to move -

That Standing Order 5.7(2) be amended as follows -

delete the words -

“(c) four other Members elected by Tynwald,
and a quorum of three Members.”

and substitute -

“(c) four other Members of Tynwald elected by Tynwald,
(d) not more than three further non-voting members, not being Members of Tynwald, appointed from time to time by the Committee,
and the quorum shall be three Members of Tynwald.”

81. Chief Minister -

The Hon Member for Rushen (Mr Gawne) to move -

That Tynwald -

- (a) recognises the extent of public concern with regard to the current criminal enquiries affecting the Chief Minister and his wife, but accepts the Chief Minister's decision to remain in office until the outcome of these enquiries is known, and
- (b) requests the Council of Ministers to examine ways in which the responsibilities of any Minister or Chief Minister in a similar situation could, if desired, be temporarily assumed by another Minister, and to report by the end of the current Session.
