**1. QUESTIONS FOR ORAL ANSWER**

1. The Hon Member for Michael (Mr Cannan) to ask the Chief Minister –  
  
Is it the policy of the Council of Ministers to agree an “out of court” settlement in the matter of the legality of the loans given by Barclays Bank to the Manx Electricity Authority/ Manx Cable Company?
  
2. The Hon Member for Onchan (Mr Karran) to ask the Chief Minister –
  - (1) What is the timescale for the Council of Ministers to release the Legal Services Commission Report to the public; and
  - (2) when will it be debated in Tynwald?
  
3. The Hon Member for Onchan (Mr Karran) to ask the Chief Minister –  
  
In view of the recent comments of the Attorney General in that it was cheaper to use UK Counsel rather than Manx advocates, what is your Government’s policy to control advocates’ fees which are said to be denying large sections of society access to justice?

4. The Hon Member for Onchan (Mr Karran) to ask the Minister for the Treasury –

What is the total of public money from -

- (a) the Department of Home Affairs;
- (b) the Department of Tourism and Leisure; and
- (c) all other Government Department or public sector bodies

received by Manx Radio in the last financial year for which records are available?

5. The Hon Member for Onchan (Mr Quirk) to ask the Minister for the Treasury -

- (1) What is the level of duty of bio-fuels; and,
- (2) if so, do you waive the full amount in order to show your commitment to becoming a greener Island?

6. The Hon Member for Michael (Mr Cannan) to ask the Minister for Transport –

Is the Department aware of the current discontent by many air travellers at the -

- (a)
  - (i) irregular provision of some airline routes;
  - (ii) unhelpful attitude of customer service when flights are cancelled at very short notice or without notice; and
- (b) what action are you taking to address the situation?

7. The Hon Member for Douglas North (Mr Houghton) to ask the Minister for Education –

- (1) When did your Department's contract with Include cease; and
- (2) who is providing education to children held in the Secure Unit?

8. The Hon Member for Douglas North (Mr Houghton) to ask the Minister for Tourism and Leisure –

Would you review bus services to Noble's Hospital with a view to creating circular bus routes through the main conurbations of Douglas and Onchan servicing the Hospital?

9. The Hon Member for Michael (Mr Cannan) to ask the Minister for Health and Social Security –

Has the Low Income Working Group identified possible additional measures to assist individuals who fail to qualify for the Winter Heating Bonus, as requested by Tynwald in October 2006?

10. The Hon Member for Michael (Mr Cannan) to ask the Minister for Health and Social Security –

(1) Are you aware that the United Kingdom Government is intending to create a National Health Service national database containing all the medical records of General Practitioners' patients;

(2) do you intend to establish a similar database for all Isle of Man residents; and

(3) do you intend to have all Isle of Man residents' medical records included on the United Kingdom national database?

What steps have been taken to review the number of management and "clip board" staff in the hospital and Health Services?

12. The Hon Member for Onchan (Mr Karran) to ask the Minister for Health and Social Security –

(1) What step is your Department taking regarding the amount of time staff spend attending meetings instead of dealing with patients; and

(2) what are your proposals to get the balance right so that the patients come first?

13. The Hon Member for Douglas North (Mr Houghton) to ask the Minister for Trade and Industry –

Will you take immediate action to provide a sufficient share of funding to enable the Manx Workshop for the Disabled to refurbish and relocate to new premises at Old Nobles?
