**11. Preservation of War Memorials -**

The Hon Member for Michael (Mr Cannan) to move -

That Tynwald requests the Council of Ministers to establish a Board of Custodians for the preservation of War Memorials and for the following purposes -

- (a) the registration of War Memorials throughout the Isle of Man;
- (b) ensuring the proper maintenance and upkeep of such Memorials;
- (c) preventing the removal or destruction of such Memorials without the consent of the Board of Custodians.

**12. Management of the Isle of Man Constabulary -**

The Hon Member for Onchan (Mr Karran) to move -

That Tynwald appoints a Committee of three Members with powers to take written and oral evidence pursuant to sections 3 and 4 of the Tynwald Proceedings Act 1876, as amended, to investigate the following matters:

- (a) the changes needed overall to promote transparency, honesty and public accountability in the constabulary;
- (b) the cost to the public purse of the inquiries into matters of police management and conduct instigated in the last six years, with an assessment of the value to the public of their respective outcomes;
- (c) the reasons for, costs of and circumstances surrounding the suspension of Deputy Chief Constable Neil Kinrade, and the terms on which his legal action arising out of it was settled;
- (d) the reasons for, costs of and circumstances surrounding the suspension of Detective Inspector Robert Kinrade;
- (e) the costs (including any damages) of civil litigation which has taken place against the Chief Constable, whether concluded by judgment or settlement;
- (f) the implementation of the recommendations of the Select Committee on the complaints of maladministration by Roy Redmayne;

and to consider in the light of such investigation whether the public interest now requires the establishment of a representative but non-political body to oversee the activities of the Island's police force, and to report with recommendations by the sitting of the Court in July 2008.
