## Election to the Legislative Council

The period for nominations by Members of the House Keys for candidates to fill the place in the Legislative Council made vacant by the death of Mr Norman Radcliffe CP MLC on 5<sup>th</sup> September has now closed. The only nomination received has been that of Mr Donald Gelling CBE MHK, the Member for Malew and Santon.

The House of Keys will sit **at 10.00 am at Douglas on Tuesday 8<sup>th</sup> October** to hold the election: the only person for whom votes may be cast at that sitting is the person nominated, Mr Donald Gelling, but not less than thirteen votes in his favour are required for him to be duly elected.
