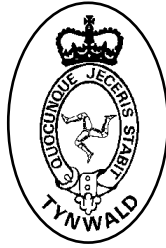

FOR ORAL ANSWER

1. The Hon Member for Michael (Mr Cannan) to ask the Chief Minister -
 - (1) Will you provide Members with a summary of the Primarolo Report with particular reference to the part that affects the Isle of Man's financial services industry; and
 - (2) will you inform Members of the Council of Minister's response to the Primarolo Report and the recommendations relating to the code of conduct?

2. The Hon Member for Douglas North (Mr Henderson) to ask the Chief Minister -

When will your Government adopt as a priority the policy of importing natural gas?

3. The Hon Member for Onchan (Mr Karran) to ask the Chief Minister -

What action is your Government going to take to ensure that those seeking rented accommodation are not exploited?

4. The Hon Member for Douglas East (Mrs Cannell) to ask HM Attorney General -

Do local authority tenants enjoy the same statutory rights as tenants of privately owned property?

5. The Hon Member for Douglas South (Mr Duggan) to ask HM Attorney General -

What are the present arrangements between the United Kingdom and the Isle of Man for recognising in one jurisdiction driving offences committed in the other?

6. The Hon Member for Onchan (Mr Karran) to ask the Minister for the Treasury -

(1) How many private sector residential properties are there in the Isle of Man; and

(2) how many of these properties are owner-occupied?

7. The Hon Member of the Council (Mr Lowey) to ask the Minister for the Treasury -

What notification is given to the relevant professional organisations of written notices given by the Financial Supervision Commission under section 10 of the Investment Business Act 1991?

8. The Hon Member for Onchan (Mr Karran) to ask the Minister for Local Government and the Environment -

Why has your Department created a fee structure within the planning procedure which does not distinguish between the major contractor and the individual householder?

9. The Hon Member for Ramsey (Mr Singer) to ask the Minister for Transport -

Will you arrange for a list of maximum taxi fares from Ronaldsway to villages and towns on the Island to be prominently displayed at the taxi rank at the Airport?

10. The Hon Member for Douglas North (Mr Henderson) to ask the Minister for Health and Social Security -

- (1) By what procedure was Crowe EPH Ltd paid £6.3 million for work carried out by the company on the construction of the new hospital; and
- (2) to what extent, if at all, was EPH (Stockport) Ltd involved in the procedure by which Crowe EPH Ltd received this payment?

11. The Hon Member for Douglas East (Mrs Cannell) to ask the Minister for Health and Social Security -

- (1) Did the tendering procedure adopted in respect of the work for which Crowe E P H Ltd was awarded contracts for the construction of the new hospital comply with the procedure prescribed by the Treasury; and
- (2) if not, in what way did they fail to comply with the prescribed procedures?

12. The Hon Member for Ayre (Mr Quine) to ask the Minister for Health and Social Security -

- (1) Can you confirm that in January 2000 either your Department or its agents entered into discussions with Crowe EPH Ltd to consider variation of the terms and conditions of the contracts of the company for work on the new hospital; and
- (2) if such discussions did take place, what were the propositions under consideration, and what was the outcome of the discussions?

13. The Hon Member for Douglas East (Mrs Cannell) to ask the Chairman of the Select Committee on the Supply of Goods and Services (Exclusion of Implied Terms) Order 1998 -

When do you expect to make a final report?

14. The Hon Member for Garff (Mr Rodan) to ask the Chairman of the Select Committee on Local Government Reform -

Do you consider it appropriate to give interviews to the media on the deliberations of a Select Committee of Tynwald, of which you are Chairman, before the Committee reports to this Hon Court?
