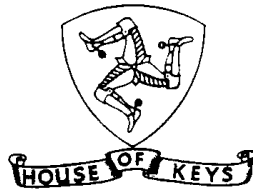

The remit of the Committee is stated in Standing Order 40  
adopted by the House on 28<sup>th</sup> January 2003

40. The Management and Members' Standards Committee shall-
- (1) consider and report on any matter which concerns the business, precincts or facilities of the House which is not within the remit of any other Committee of the House or Mr Speaker alone;
  - (2) represent the House in all matters brought before any chambers of the Legislature other than legislation, and to report thereon from time to time to the House;
  - (3) consider and report upon any matter that may from time to time be referred to the Committee by the House, or by a Member, which relates to the conduct of a Member;
  - (4) consider and report on such standards and such privileges of the House and of Members as have been, or in the future should be, recognised as necessary and desirable for the proper and effective discharge of the duties of the House and its Members.

### FIRST REPORT FOR THE SESSION 2004-05

#### THE CHAPLAIN OF THE HOUSE

1. Following the unexpected and sad death of Canon Dennis Baggaley MA, the Chaplain of the House since October 1998, your Committee have met to consider the nominations Members have made for the appointment of a new Chaplain.
2. Standing Order 19 provides:

*At the first meeting of the House after a General Election (or on a vacancy occurring in the office), the House shall elect some person to be Chaplain of the House.*
3. In accordance with past practice, Members were invited on 11<sup>th</sup> February 2005 to nominate members of the clergy whom they considered appropriate for election under this Standing Order. Five nominations were received in response to this invitation.
4. In considering the persons proposed, your Committee have been principally influenced by the nature and extent of their service to the Isle of Man and whether, having regard to their other responsibilities, their circumstances fitted them for the duties of the office of Chaplain of the House. After careful consideration, we have decided to recommend the appointment of the Revd George Quinn MBE, whose curriculum vitae is at Appendix 1.

5. As will be seen, Mr Quinn has had a distinguished record of service to the Island and is well known to a large number of people through his work with the Board of Social Security, retiring as a senior Civil Servant. Mr Quinn is also well known in Douglas for his pastoral care in the community and is in active good health; he was awarded the MBE in Her Majesty's New Year's Honours List in 2005 for service to the community. By reason of his age, Mr Quinn has indicated that he would not wish to seek re-election as Chaplain after the forthcoming General Election.
6. At Appendix 2, for Members' information, is a list of the Chaplains of the House in modern times.
7. **Your Committee accordingly recommend that the Revd George Bruce Quinn MBE be elected Chaplain of the House to serve during the life of this House.**
