(). *In the Companies Act 1982 (c.2), after section 14(8) insert -*

“ (8A) Notwithstanding anything in the foregoing provisions of this section, a limited liability company established under the Limited Liability Companies Act 1996 (c.19) (in this subsection referred to as an “LLC”) shall be qualified for appointment as auditor of a company if, but only if, -

- (a) all the members of the LLC are individuals who are qualified for appointment as auditor of the company; and*
- (b) no provision is made in the articles of organisation of the LLC for the management of the LLC to be vested in a manager.”*
