Notes

1. Column 6 shows the Supplementary Capital Vote required to authorise the overspending of the Vote that occurred in the last Financial Year. Exceeding the Vote for the year does not necessarily imply that the total cost of the project approved by Tynwald has been exceeded. Exceeding the Vote for the year can arise simply because a project proceeds faster than originally estimated.

2. Column 7 shows overspending of the project, if any, against the total cost of the project previously approved by Tynwald.
3. Excess spending by the Department of Transport, the Department of Local Government and the Environment and the Department of Health and Social Security on the unplanned acquisition of land or property is to be financed by a transfer of £2,248,490 from the Land and Property Acquisition Reserve. That expenditure required and received the prior approval of the Treasury.

- (1) The Clerk of Tynwald shall be responsible for ensuring that an audio recording of all proceedings of the Court is made, and that such recording is transcribed and published.
 - (2) Unless otherwise determined by a quorum of each Branch, no such recording shall be made in any case in which a motion under Standing Order 3.35(2) - Exclusion of Strangers - has been carried.
 - (3) Subject to paragraph (2) above, if it is impossible for a recording pursuant to paragraph (1) above to be made of any proceedings, the Clerk of Tynwald shall at once draw that circumstance to the attention of the President, who shall adjourn the Court to such time as recording can commence.

- (5) Delete Standing order 5.7(3) and substitute -
- (3) Members of Tynwald shall not be eligible for membership of the Committee if, for the time being, they hold any of the following offices: President of Tynwald, Speaker of the House of Keys, Member of the Council of Ministers, member of the Treasury Department referred to in section 1(2)(b) of the Government Departments Act 1987.
- (6) Add to Standing Order 5.1(2) -
- , except the Tynwald Management Committee, the Tynwald Ceremony Arrangements Committee (of which the President shall be chairman *ex officio*), the Tynwald Honours Committee and the Tynwald Members' Pension Scheme Management Committee.
- (7) Delete Standing order 5.6(1) and substitute -
- (1) At the first sitting of Tynwald after a general election of the Keys, Tynwald shall appoint a Standing Orders Committee consisting of the Speaker of the House of Keys, two Members of the Keys and two Members of the Council, to hold office until the next succeeding dissolution of the Keys, and shall from time to time fill any vacancy that may arise.
- (8) The Declaration of Members' Interests Committee shall be discontinued and the Members elected to serve on the Committee shall be discharged from duty.
- (9) Renumber Standing Order 5.8 as 5.9 and insert new Standing Order 5.8 -

Standards and Members' Interests

- 5.8 (1) There shall be a Standing Committee on Standards and Members' Interests.
- (2) The Committee shall be chaired by the Speaker of the House of Keys, and composed of the members of the Management and Members Standards Committee of the Keys, and two Members of the Council elected by that Branch.
- (3) The Committee shall consider and report upon any matter that may from time to time be referred to the Committee by the Court, or by a Member, which relates to the conduct of a Member.
- (4) The Committee shall also consider and report on such standards and such privileges of the Court and of Members as have been, or in the future should be, recognised as necessary and desirable for the proper and effective discharge of the duties of the Court of Tynwald and its Members.

- (5) The Registrar of Members' Interests shall maintain a Register, to be known as the Register of Members' Interests.
- (6) The Committee shall from time to time, and subject to the approval of Tynwald, establish rules for the Register of Members' Interests, specifying the type of interests which must be registered, the manner in which the Register is to be kept, the time limits within which a Member must notify changes to it and the circumstances in which it is to be open to inspection by the public.
- (7) The Clerk of Tynwald shall be the Registrar of Members' Interests and shall be responsible to the Committee for maintaining the Register and for giving effect to the rules referred to in paragraph (6) above.
- (10) That Tynwald approves in principle the introduction of an electronic voting system with the facilities described at paragraph 11.2 of the Second Report of the Tynwald Standing Orders Committee for the Session 2002-2003, to be introduced consistently with the timetable for the refurbishment of the Tynwald Chamber.

Mrs Craine, Capt. Douglas, Mr Gawne, Mr Houghton, Mr Singer and Mr Speaker were nominated.

After a second ballot Mrs Craine and Mr Speaker were elected.

48. Standing Orders Committee of Tynwald -

To elect four Members of Tynwald, two of whom must be Members of the Council and two of whom must be Members of the Keys to serve during the life of the House of Keys.

Mrs Crowe, Mr Delaney and Mr Lowey were nominated for the Council.

Mr Cannan, Mr Gawne, Mrs Hannan, Mr Karran and Mr Quayle were nominated for the Keys.

After a ballot Mrs Crowe and Mr Lowey were elected for the Council.

After a ballot Mrs Hannan and Mr Quayle were elected for the Keys.

49. Tynwald Management Committee -

To elect one Member of Tynwald to serve during the life of the House of Keys in place of Mrs Crowe.

Mr Cannan, Mrs Crowe, Mr Gawne and Mr Waft were nominated.

After a second ballot Mr Waft was elected.

50. Acknowledgement for Retired Police Officers -

Motion not put.

51. Department of Health and Social Security -

Motion not put.

52. Reorganisation of the Department of Health and Social Security -

Motion made -

Tynwald is of the opinion that the Council of Ministers should report back to the October sitting:

- (a) whether the DHSS should be divided into two separate Government Departments, and review the existing Departments for amalgamation in order to keep the status quo of the number of Departments in government;
- (b) to investigate the services of the DHSS having more input from lay members of the public; and
- (c) to investigate the creation of a Health Authority or a Hospital Administration Committee and a Social Services Committee, and to review and recommend changes to the structure of the DHSS.
