

**Road Races (Temporary Modification) Bill 2014 –
Third Reading approved**

Mr Turner to move:

That the Road Races (Temporary Modification) Bill 2014 be read a third time.

The President: Third Reading.

Mr Turner: Thank you, Madam President, and a very short Third Reading.

I thank Members for all their support this morning, notwithstanding the points made by Mr Coleman – and I do take them on board because it was a discussion I had at length with the Department, about legislation. They have been left completely certain of what my view is on this and, as I said, the previous Bill I did say will have to go through a different process.

But I hope Members will support this for the Third Reading so we can get it on the way to getting it enacted.

It is the Road Races (Temporary Modification) Bill 2014; it enables the Department to issue a Road Racing Order for Sunday 31st May this year only; it will expire at the end of that day, and it will facilitate racing on the Billown Circuit.

The reason, as I have explained is due to the dates of the TT and where the Bank Holiday is, and that is the reason behind this. I hope Members will support.

I beg to move the Bill be read a third time and do pass.

Mr Downie: I beg to second, Madam President, and reserve my remarks.
