

**3. Standing Orders Committee of the Legislative Council –
Mr Cretney elected**

To elect a member in place of Mr Wild.

The other members of the Committee are HMAG (ex officio), Mr President and Mr Corkish.

The President: We turn to Item 3, Standing Orders Committee of Legislative Council and we require to elect a Member to replace Mr Wild. May I hear nominations, please?

Mr Coleman.

5 **Mr Coleman:** Mr President, I would like to propose Mr Corkish.

Several Members: He is already on.

10 **The President:** Mr Corkish is a Member. *(Interjections)*

Mr Coleman: You are already on it? Oh, okay.

The President: HM Attorney General, *ex-officio*, myself and Mr Corkish are the other members.

15 **Mr Coleman:** I would like to propose Mr Henderson.

The President: Mr Henderson.

20 **Mr Corkish:** I would like to second Mr Henderson, Mr President.

Mr Crookall: Can I propose Mr Cretney, Mr President?

25 **The President:** Proposal of Mr Cretney.

Mrs Poole-Wilson: I would like to second Mr Cretney.

30 **The President:** Second Mr Cretney.
We have two nominations. In that case we require an election.
The Clerk to the Council will produce ballot papers.

A ballot took place and voting resulted as follows:

Vote Results	
Mr Cretney	5
Mr Henderson	4

The President: The result of the ballot is that Mr Cretney received 5 votes; Mr Henderson received 4 votes. Mr Cretney is therefore elected.
