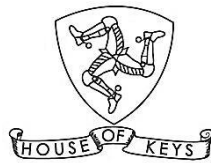

2. Questions for Oral Answer

1. The Hon. Member for Onchan (Ms Edge) to ask the Chief Minister –

How the Immigration Office is informed when a migrant worker holding an immigration visa ceases employment?

2. The Hon. Member for Onchan (Ms Edge) to ask the Chief Minister –

To what extent U.K. issued visas that allow a migrant to work are recognised by the Isle of Man to allow the migrant to work; and on what policy basis?

3. The Hon. Member for Onchan (Ms Edge) to ask the Chief Minister –

Whether Isle of Man Immigration Visas for migrant workers are recognised in the United Kingdom for work purposes?

4. The Hon. Member for Arbory, Castletown and Malew (Mr Moorhouse) to ask the Minister for Infrastructure –

If he will make a statement on the registration of vehicles arriving on Island?

5. The Hon. Member for Garff (Mrs Caine) to ask the Minister for Infrastructure –

2. The Hon. Member for Douglas East (Mrs Barber) to ask the Chief Minister (Minister for the Cabinet Office) –

What isolation instructions were communicated to each person permitted to travel to the Isle of Man up to 1st October 2020, broken down by traveller category and associated timeframe for receipt of instructions; how these were communicated; and what changes were made to instructions and how they were communicated since this date?

3. The Hon. Member for Onchan (Ms Edge) to ask the Minister for the Treasury –

If he will make a statement on the economic value of private sector rental accommodation to the Government?

4. The Hon. Member for Douglas Central (Mrs Corlett) to ask the Minister for the Treasury –

How many people receive bereavement payments; and, of those, how many have children under the age of 18 years?

5. The Hon. Member for Douglas East (Mrs Barber) to ask the Minister for Policy and Reform –

What definition of Critical National Infrastructure applies to Department of Infrastructure workers who enter the Island as keyworkers?

6. The Hon. Member for Douglas Central (Mr Thomas) to ask the Minister for Policy and Reform –

What residential land is available; what employment land is available; how many domestic properties are (i) vacant and (ii) under-occupied; how many non-domestic properties are (i) vacant and (ii) under-occupied; and how many urban sites are unoccupied, each category broken down by Strategic Plan area?

How many jobs the locate.im strategy has created and what the associated value to the economy was, broken down by sector, in each of the last five years?

If he will make a statement on his policy on maintaining dark skies on the Island; and how this policy is being implemented?
9. The Hon. Member for Douglas Central (Mr Thomas) to ask the Minister for Enterprise –
If he will estimate the flat and house average price and transaction volume (a) in the last 12 months; (b) three years ago; (c) ten years ago; and (d) twenty years ago based on (i) on Land Registry data and (ii) other sources; and if he will make a statement?
10. The Hon. Member for Douglas Central (Mrs Corlett) to ask the Minister for Environment, Food and Agriculture –
How many complaints have been received by the planning department in the last 3 years in relation to yellow notices that have (a) not been displayed (b) not been displayed properly or (c) been removed; how many such complaints were upheld; and what enforcement took place?
