3. Government's response to Coronavirus (COVID-19)

The Chief Minister to move –

That Tynwald notes:

1. That Government continues to follow its four Key Principles, as set out in the Stay Safe Medium Term Response to COVID-19 document [[GD No 2020/0013](#)];
2. That Government's response to the pandemic is to eliminate the virus by:
 - a) Eliminating community transmission;
 - b) Containing cases to the point of entry;
 - c) Preventing disease and death from COVID-19;
 - d) Utilising an appropriate testing regime that responds to the changing external threat;
 - e) Deploying proportionate measures;
 - f) Delivering an appropriate vaccination programme when available; and
3. That Government's medium to long term strategy will be brought to Tynwald in January 2021.
