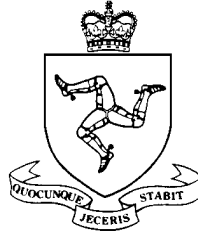

IN THE COUNCIL  
BUILDING CONTROL (AMENDMENT) BILL  
AMENDMENTS MADE BY THE KEYS

Page 1, line 7, after “demolition”, insert “, buildings”.

Page 2, for line 4, substitute –

“(2) For section 1(2) and (3), substitute –

“(2) Schedule 1 has effect for the matters about which regulations may provide.

(3) Schedule 1 does not limit subsection (1).”.

Page 2, for lines 5 and 6, substitute –

“4. (1) In section 2(1), after “frustrated”, insert “or for a purpose mentioned in section 1(1)”.

(1A) In section 2(2), for “Building regulations”, substitute “Without limiting section 1 or subsection (1), building regulations”.

Page 9, line 25, for “sections 2(2) and 2A”, substitute “section 2(2)”.

Page 2, line 11 to page 3, line 8 –  
Clause 5 omitted.

Page 4, line 5 –  
Clause 9 omitted.

Page 7, after line 22, add –

**“15A Section 37 (Tynwald approval of regulations etc) substituted**

For section 37, substitute –

**“37 Procedure for building regulations and exemption directions**

(1) Before making a building regulation or a direction under section 3(2) (“subordinate legislation”), the Department must –

(a) prepare a draft of the subordinate legislation;

(b) publish a public notice stating –

(i) that it has prepared draft subordinate legislation;

(ii) where the draft may be inspected; and

(iii) that anyone may make written submissions to it about the draft within a stated period of at least 6 weeks; and

(c) consider any written submissions made to it about the draft during the stated period.

- (2) After complying with subsection (1), the Department may make the subordinate legislation with or without changes from the draft.
- (3) The subordinate legislation must be laid before Tynwald as soon as practicable after its making.
- (4) At the second sitting of Tynwald after the subordinate legislation has been laid, the Department must cause one of the following to be done—
  - (a) the moving of a motion to Tynwald that it approves the subordinate legislation;
  - (b) an advice to Tynwald that the Department does not wish to have the subordinate legislation approved.
- (5) The subordinate legislation has no effect unless Tynwald approves it under a motion mentioned in subsection (4)(a).

**37A Procedure for orders about building authorities**

- (1) Before making an order under section 34(2), the Department must consult with the local authority affected by the order.
- (2) The order has no effect unless it is approved by Tynwald.

**37B Order about approved documents to be laid before Tynwald**

An order under section 4 must be laid before Tynwald as soon as practicable after it is made.”.”.

AMENDMENTS MADE BY THE KEYS

Page 2, for lines 5 to 9, substitute –

“ “ “appointment recommendation” has the meaning given under section 3E(1) and (3);”.

Page 3, lines 28 to 30, from “Appointments” to “recommendation”).” substitute the following and adjust the numbering of succeeding subsections accordingly –

“the recommendation (an “appointment recommendation”) of an interview panel.

“(2) The interview panel is comprised of the following persons as its members –

- (a) the Minister, as its chairperson;
- (b) the Minister’s appointee;
- (c) two other persons appointed by the Council of Ministers.”.

Page 4, for line 8, substitute –

“can be appointed to the interview panel under subsection (2)(c) or be a Council of Ministers appointee.

(6) Despite subsections (1) and (3), the appointment of a Council of Ministers appointee does not take effect until it is approved by Tynwald.”.

Page 5, line 29, for “must”, substitute “may”.
