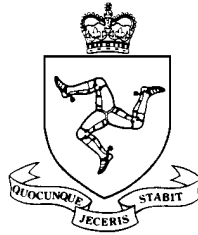

1. Questions for oral answer

1. The Hon Member of the Council, Mr Lowey, to ask a representative of the Chief Minister –
 - (1) If he and the Council of Ministers will create a register of all those, whether paid or unpaid, who advise Ministers in the exercise of their Ministerial roles; and
 - (2) if in the interests of openness and transparency that register will be made public and updated quarterly?

2. The Hon Member of the Council, Mr Lowey, to ask a representative of the Chief Minister –
 - (1) Why the Isle of Man was not represented at the recent Labour and Conservative Party conferences held in Liverpool and Manchester respectively;
 - (2) how such non-attendance chimes with the Government's policy of a high profile in external affairs; and
 - (3) whether he is aware of the approach taken by the Channel Islands to attendance at UK party conferences?
