1. The Hon. Member for Douglas South (Mrs Beecroft) to ask the Chief Minister -

When the Appointed Day Order will be made relating to the Tynwald Commissioner for Administration?

2. The Hon. Member for Douglas South (Mrs Beecroft) to ask the Chief Minister -

How many people with disabilities are employed by Government; and what this is as a percentage of total employees?

3. The Hon. Member for Douglas South (Mrs Beecroft) to ask the Minister for Economic Development -

What schemes there are and what schemes are planned to assist those with disabilities to find employment?

4. The Hon. Member for Douglas East (Mrs Cannell) to ask the Minister for Health -

What written assurances have been given from the Linda McCartney Centre and Whiston Hospital that NHS breast cancer patients have not received French PIP implants as part of their breast reconstruction procedures?

5. The Hon. Member for Rushen (Mr Skelly) to ask the Minister for Health -

8. The Hon. Member for Middle (Mr Quayle) to ask the Minister for Environment, Food and Agriculture -

Pursuant to his Department's undertaking to ensure that farmers on the Island would receive an equivalent payment for their animals as farmers in the UK, what plans he has to support the meat plant and remove the incentive to export live animals?
