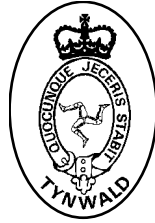

- (v) seek alternative approaches to giving more assistance rather than financial support; and
- (vi) create stricter controls;

Motion made -

That Tynwald receives the Treasury Report on Public Broadcasting Subvention of July 2012 [[GD 0034/12](#)]; and -

- (a) reaffirms its commitment to public service broadcasting in the Isle of Man;
- (b) endorses Manx Radio as the Isle of Man's national broadcaster and the current interpretation of its public service broadcasting requirement;
- (c) is of the opinion that Manx Radio should receive a level of Government support necessary to allow it to continue to deliver public service broadcasting over the next three years; and
- (d) is of the opinion that independent advice should be obtained to allow Tynwald to decide the service it requires from its public broadcasting service and to assess the cost of the options available.
