

## **Explanatory Memorandum to Tynwald Members**

Issued by the Department for Enterprise

**To the Hon Laurence Skelly MLC, President of Tynwald and the Hon Council and Keys in Tynwald assembled**

**1. Title of measure**

Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Flying Displays – Red Arrows) Regulations 2021 (SD 2021/0270)

**2. Changes in policy**

None.

**3. Effects of the measure**

These Regulations temporarily restricted flying in the airspace referred to in regulation 3(2) in order that a Red Arrows flying display could take place on 28 August 2021.

**4. Reasons for the measure**

The restriction to flying is required to enhance safety and prevent disruption to the red arrows during the aerial display.

**5. Resource implications**

None.

**6. Tynwald procedure**

The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Flying Displays – Red Arrows) Regulations 2021 are made under Article 92 of the Air Navigation (Isle of Man) Order 2015 (SI 2015/870). Although there is no explicit Tynwald procedure required within the Order, the Attorney General's Chambers have advised that the Regulations should be laid before Tynwald.
