BURMA AND MISAPPROPRIATION SANCTIONS (REVOCAION) (NO. 2) REGULATIONS 2021

Approved by Tynwald:

Coming into Operation in accordance with regulation 2

The Council of Ministers makes the following Regulations under section 19 of, and Schedule 4 to, the European Union and Trade Act 2019.

The Council of Ministers is of the opinion that, by reason of urgency, it is necessary to make these Regulations subject to the Tynwald procedure set out in section 31 of the Legislation Act 2015 (“affirmative”) instead of the “approval required” Tynwald procedure applied by virtue of section 19(1) of the European Union and Trade Act 2019¹.

1 Title

These Regulations are the Burma and Misappropriation Sanctions (Revocation) (No. 2) Regulations 2021.

2 Commencement

These Regulations come into operation on 7 September 2021².

3 Revocations

The following Regulations are revoked —

- (a) the Burma Sanctions (Application) Regulations 2020³;
 - (b) the Misappropriation Sanctions (Application) Regulations 2020⁴;
- and

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations revoke the Burma Sanctions (Application) Regulations 2020 and the Misappropriation Sanctions (Application) Regulations 2020. Those Regulations applied the Burma Sanctions (EU Exit) Regulations 2020, the Misappropriation (Sanctions) (EU Exit) Regulations 2020 and certain provisions of the Sanctions and Anti-Money Laundering Act 2018 to the Island subject to modifications, etc.

These Regulations also revoke the Burma and Misappropriation Sanctions (Revocation) Regulations 2021, which contained a legislative error.

The revocations made by these Regulations follow the revocation of the Burma Sanctions (EU Exit) Regulations 2020 and the Misappropriation (Sanctions) (EU Exit) Regulations 2020 in the United Kingdom.

The sanctions regime that was established in relation to Burma (Myanmar) by the Burma Sanctions (EU Exit) Regulations 2020 has been replaced by the one established by the Myanmar (Sanctions) Regulations 2021. Those 2021 Regulations have been extended to the Island by the Myanmar (Sanctions) (Isle of Man) Order 2021⁶.

The sanctions regime that was established by the Misappropriation (Sanctions) (EU Exit) Regulations 2020 has been replaced by the one established by the Global Anti-Corruption Sanctions Regulations 2021. Those 2021 Regulations have been extended to the Island by the Global Anti-Corruption Sanctions (Isle of Man) Order 2021⁷.
