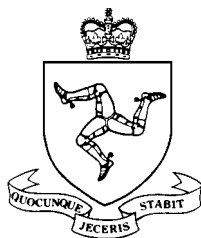

3. Page 22, after line 9 insert the following new clause —

“30 Amendment of the Emergency Powers Act 1936

- (1) The Emergency Powers Act 1936 is amended as follows.
- (2) In section 4A (continuation of emergency regulations), after subsection (3) there is inserted —
- “(3A) Tynwald may, in approving continuation regulations, amend them.” (Mrs K Lord-Brennan MLC)
