

AMERICAN GOOSEBERRY MILDEW.

Attention is called to an Order of the Board of Agriculture and Fisheries, dated March 30th, 1912, and designated the "American Gooseberry Mildew (Fruit) Order 1912."

Article 4 of the Order requires consignments of gooseberries imported into England and Wales from the Isle of Man to be specially labelled.

All exporters of this fruit should apply for copies of the Order, to the Government Office.
