



OLD AGE PENSIONS.

His Excellency the Lieutenant-Governor has been pleased to appoint a Commission for the purpose of ascertaining:—

- (1) The number of persons in the Island who would be entitled to receive Old Age Pensions if an Act corresponding to the Imperial Old Age Pension Act were operative in the Island;
- (2) The cost of payment of such pensions and of the administration of the Act.
