### STOPPAGE OF IMPORTATION OF ANIMALS.

---

Owing to outbreaks of Foot-and-Mouth Disease having occurred in Great Britain and Ireland, His Excellency the Lieutenant-Governor has issued, under authority of the Cattle Diseases Prevention Act, 1865, an Order dated July 1st, 1912, prohibiting for the present, until further orders, the importation into the Isle of Man of any Bull, Cow, Ox, Heifer, Steer, Calf, Sheep, Swine, or Goat.
