



FOOT AND MOUTH DISEASE.

Movement of Cattle from the Old Cattle Market, Douglas.

His Excellency the Lieutenant-Governor has issued, under the authority of the "Cattle Diseases Prevention Act, 1865," an Order dated the 4th July, 1912, prohibiting the removal of any animal at present detained in the Old Cattle Market, Heywood Place, in the borough of Douglas, unless a Government veterinary surgeon has first certified the same to be free from Foot and Mouth Disease.

The Order further prohibits any animal or unauthorized person being admitted into the said Cattle Market during the continuance of such Order.
