



FOOT-AND-MOUTH DISEASE.

Prohibition of Importation of Peat-Moss Litter.

With a view of preventing the introduction into this Island of Foot-and-Mouth Disease through the agency of Peat-Moss Litter, His Excellency the Lieutenant-Governor has issued, under the authority of the Cattle Diseases Prevention Acts, an Order, dated the 7th October, 1912, prohibiting as from that date the importation into the Island of this article, as well as of any other substance used in substitution for Straw for bedding of Animals.
