



## Importation of Animals, Hay, Straw, and Peat Moss.

---

His Excellency the Lieutenant-Governor has issued two important Orders under the Cattle Diseases Acts.

On and after 17th February, 1913, until further orders—

- (1) Hay, Straw, and Peat Moss will be admitted to the Island from the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland and the Channel Islands;
- (2) Cattle, Sheep, Goats, and Swine will be admitted to the Island from the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland, and the Channel Islands, on the terms laid out in the Order.

The Government Lairs for the time being will be the Old Cattle Market, Douglas, to which address all communications to the Superintendent should be made.
