



Definition of "Cattle Plague."

His Excellency the Lieutenant-Governor has issued an Order dated 17th February, 1913, under which the expression "Cattle Plague," for the purpose of compensation for compulsorily destroyed animals under the Cattle Diseases Prevention Acts, shall extend to rinderpest, pleuro-pneumonia, anthrax, foot-and-mouth disease, glanders, farcy, and swine fever.
