

Government Circular No. 36.



Attention is directed to Section 90 of the Patents and Designs Act, 1907 (an Act of the Imperial Parliament), which renders a person liable to a fine of £20, who, without the authority of His Majesty, uses in connection with any business, trade, calling, or profession, the Royal Arms in such manner as to be calculated to lead to the belief that he is duly authorized to use the Royal Arms.
