



LOTTERIES OR RAFFLES AT BAZAARS, &c.

The attention of persons organising Bazaars, and others concerned, is directed to the Lottery Act, 1839, which renders any person liable to a fine of £500, or, in default of payment, to imprisonment for any period not exceeding three years, who sets up or keeps any place for the sale of goods or other things (specified in section 1.) by way of lottery, or by lots, tickets, numbers or figures, cards or dice.

The Police throughout the Island will keep strict watch for the holding of any such lottery or raffle, and in the event of detection will at once communicate to the Government Office, through the usual channel, a full report into all the circumstances, at the same time transmitting the names and addresses of the organizers of such lottery or raffle.
