### PARTIAL STOPPAGE OF IMPORTATION OF ANIMALS FROM ENGLAND AND SCOTLAND.

---

Owing to an outbreak of Foot-and-Mouth Disease having occurred in the North of England, His Excellency the Lieutenant-Governor has issued, under authority of the Cattle Diseases Prevention Act, 1865, an Order dated 19th February, 1914, prohibiting for the present, until further orders, the importation into the Isle of Man of any Bull, Cow, Ox, Heifer, Steer, Calf, Sheep, Swine, or Goat from any port in England and Scotland, except the port of Liverpool.
