



FOOT-AND-MOUTH DISEASE.

GENERAL STOPPAGE OF IMPORTATION OF ANIMALS.

Owing to outbreaks of Foot-and-Mouth Disease having occurred in England and Ireland, His Excellency the Lieutenant-Governor has issued, under authority of the Cattle Diseases Prevention Act, 1865, Orders dated respectively 2nd February, 1914, and 24th February, 1914, prohibiting for the present, until further orders, the importation into the Isle of Man of any Bull, Cow, Ox, Heifer, Steer, Calf, Sheep, Swine, or Goat, from any port in Great Britain and Ireland.
