



## CATTLE DISEASES ACTS.

### Withdrawal of General Stoppage Orders.

---

His Excellency the Lieutenant-Governor has issued an Order dated 21st day of April, 1914, cancelling the Orders of 2nd February, 1914, and 24th February, 1914, and allowing the Importation of Cattle, Sheep, Swine, or Goats into the Isle of Man on the following conditions:

- (1.) A permit to import any such animal must first be obtained from Government Office.
- (2.) On a permit being granted, the importation of animals will be regulated by the "Animals (Importation) Order" of the 12th February, 1913.

Importers are warned, that for the present at any rate, certain animals will be liable to detention at the Government Lairs, Douglas, for a period of at least four days.
