## GOVERNMENT REGULATIONS.

1. The Commandant shall be appointed by the Lieutenant-Governor, and shall comply with all such directions as the Lieutenant-Governor shall from time to time issue.
2. The Commandant shall be in sole disciplinary control of the Association, and all Members shall submit to his orders.
3. The Company and Section Commanders of each Company shall be elected by the Members of the Company, with the approval of the Commandant.
4. The Association, with the approval of the Commandant, may make Rules for the conduct of the Association, and every Member joining the Association shall agree to abide by such Rules and by the Government Regulations.
