



## EXPORTATION AND IMPORTATION OF HORSES, &c.

---

THE requirements as to the movement of horses, &c., notified in Government Circular number 92 have been modified as follows:—

- (1) Pack, saddle, and draught animals suitable for use in war may be exported from the Isle of Man to ports in Great Britain and Ireland.
  
- (2) Pack, saddle, and draught animals suitable for use in war may be imported into the Isle of Man from Great Britain, but may not be imported into the Isle of Man from Ireland unless accompanied by a licence from the Commissioners of Customs and Excise to export prohibited or restricted goods.
